

RANDALL RECYCLING

ALUMINUM, STEEL, TIN

ACCEPTABLE

- Steel/tin cans (rinsed & label removed)
- Aluminum cans (emptied)
- Please crush or flatten

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Cardboard cans
- Metalized-look plastics
- Aerosol cans, wire strapping
- Aluminum foil, meat & pie tins

NEWSPAPER

ACCEPTABLE

- Newspaper-please bag or bundle
- All newspaper inserts including glossy
- Cardboard-please flatten & bundle

MAGAZINES & CATALOGS

ACCEPTABLE

- All magazines & catalogs accepted. Please bag or bundle separate from newspaper

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Phonebooks

GLASS

ACCEPTABLE

- Unbroken clear, brown, green & blue glass bottles/jars (empty)
- Labels need not be removed
- Empty, rinsed clean
- Covers/lids removed

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Ceramic dishes/clay pots
- Window panes, mirrors, light bulbs
- Drinking glasses, crystal

PLASTIC

ACCEPTABLE

- Plastic bottles & jugs with #1 or #2 on bottom (bottle type only, with necks)
- Rinsed & caps must be removed
- Please crush or flatten

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Plastic bags, bottle caps
- 1 gallon – 5 gallon pails
- Plastics with any other number
- Plastic utensils, lids, plastic cups, oil jugs
- Plastic flower pots

SPECIAL NOTES

- Please place recyclables in your City provided recycle bin or in CLEAR plastic bags.
- Plastic, glass, tin & aluminum can be co-mingled in recycle bin or CLEAR plastic bags.
- Please be advised that separate trucks are used for refuse & recycling. On days when both are collected, they likely WILL NOT be picked up at the same time.
